



Prof. Dr. Lazar Savin, full professor, is employed at the Faculty of Agriculture, Novi Sad, University of Novi Sad. SCOPUS 54791570100. ORCID 0000-0001-9414-6016

He was born on March 9, 1969 in Farkaždin, municipality of Zrenjanin, where he finished elementary school. In 1988, he graduated from the secondary agricultural school "Servo Mihalj" in Zrenjanin, majoring in Mechanization and rationalization, and graduated the same year. He graduated from the Faculty of Agriculture in Novi Sad, Department of Agricultural Techniques and Rationalization, on January 6, 1995, when he defended his graduation thesis entitled "Analysis of the exploitation of a

stationary comber for seed corn in the processing center of PIK "Bečej". He enrolled in postgraduate studies in the academic year 1995/96, majoring in Plant Production Technology, at the Faculty of Agriculture in Novi Sad, and completed the academic year 1998/99. He defended his Master's thesis entitled "The influence of tractors of different categories on soil changes" on 30 July 1999. He also defended his doctoral dissertation at the Faculty of Agriculture: "Optimization of the composition of the machinery fleet in agriculture." in 2012 and to the title of full professor in 2017.

He is engaged in teaching at all three levels of academic studies. He was a mentor for one doctoral dissertation, a mentor for one master's thesis and over 10 diploma or final theses. In co-authorship with other colleagues, he published 7 basic textbooks. Together with his colleagues, he participated in the formation of the National Station, i.e. the laboratory for official testing of tractors according to OECD Regulations and other laboratory facilities. He was also the manager of an accredited seminar for secondary school teachers.

The narrower field of scientific work is propulsion machines, tractors and mobile systems - development, testing and use. He published: 20 papers in international journals from the ISI-JCR-SCI list, 28 papers at international meetings, 18 chapters in monographs and 287 papers in journals of national significance. The total number of citations is 358, heterocitations 238 and the h index is 12. He is a reviewer of papers for ISI-JCR-SCI journals: Turkish Journal of Agriculture and Forestry and Technology Analysis & Strategic Management, as well as for 2 national journals Contemporary Agricultural Techniques and Tractors and Driven Machines. He is a participant in a large number of national projects, of which he was the manager of two. He also participated in 2 international projects, the topic of which was energy efficiency. Member of the program committees of several scientific meetings on the development and use of agricultural tractors and mobile systems.

In engineering, he is the co-author of 9 technical solutions, which were developed within national and provincial projects. A certain number of technical solutions were realized by directly signing cooperation contracts with private companies, such as, for example, the design of protective structures for tractors. He is the technical manager of the Laboratory for Driven Machines and Tractors, Faculty of Agriculture, Novi Sad - National Test Station for official testing of tractors according to OECD Standard Codes. President of the Scientific Society for Power Machines, Tractors and Maintenance - JUMTO, in Novi Sad.

In international cooperation, he made a number of short stays that included both visits to global companies and visits to universities and scientific institutes. One part of the trip was realized through the Tempus and Erasmus programs. He is a representative of the Republic of Serbia and a member of the OECD Assembly for official testing of agricultural and forestry tractors in Paris, France, since 2006, and since 2018 he is a representative of the Republic of Serbia and a member of the Club of Bologna, Italy.

All the time he worked at the Faculty, he actively participated in its organizational affairs. He was a member of the Central Commission for conducting the entrance exam at the Faculty of Agriculture in Novi Sad, and from 2008 to 2012, its president. He was vice-dean for teaching at the Faculty of Agriculture in 2012-2015, vice-dean for finance and cooperation with the economy in 2015-2018,

and vice-dean for finance in 2018-2023. He has been the president of the Council of the University of Novi Sad 2016-2023.
